

Stockinette Squares No Sew Blanket

Executive Summary



Finished size: 42" x 56"

Materials:

- 10 skeins of Cotton Kureyon (50 gm -110 yards) (This yarn has been discontinued, but is the same put-up as the wool Kuryeon.)
- 4 skeins of Sierra (100g - 192 yds)
- Set of 5 dpn in size needed to get gauge
- 1 16 inch circular needle, same size

Gauge: 4.5 sts per inch in stockinette

Notions

- extra circulars for holding squares
- narrow ribbon
- blunt sewing up needle.

Squares

Using circular beginning of your choice, cast on 8 sts.

Divide over 4 dpns, 2 on each needle. Mark beginning of round. Knit one round.

Round 1: Knit

Round 2: K1, M1, knit to last stitch on the needle, M1, K1, repeat for each needle.

Repeat these two rounds until there are 20 sts on each needle.

Change to the 16 inch circular needle, placing markers before the last stitch on one needle and after the first stitch on the next, repeating until all stitches are on the circular needle.

After there are 40 sts between markers, (one side of the square) break yarn, put stitches on piece of ribbon or circular needle.

Make 12 squares.

Sashing to Connect Squares (see layout diagram)

Put stitches from one side of square onto circular needle. With the Sierra, knit 20 rows (10 garter ridges)

Join the last row of the garter stitch to one side of another square, using grafting or 3-needle bind off.

Sashing on long side of the strip: Using Sierra, pick up 194 stitches on long side of the blanket. Work 20 rows (10 ridges) of garter stitch. Pick up 194 stitches along side of next strip, using Sierra, work three-needle bind off.

With Sierra, work log cabin strips around all four sides, as in layout diagram.

If desired, work a perpendicular garter stitch border.

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
